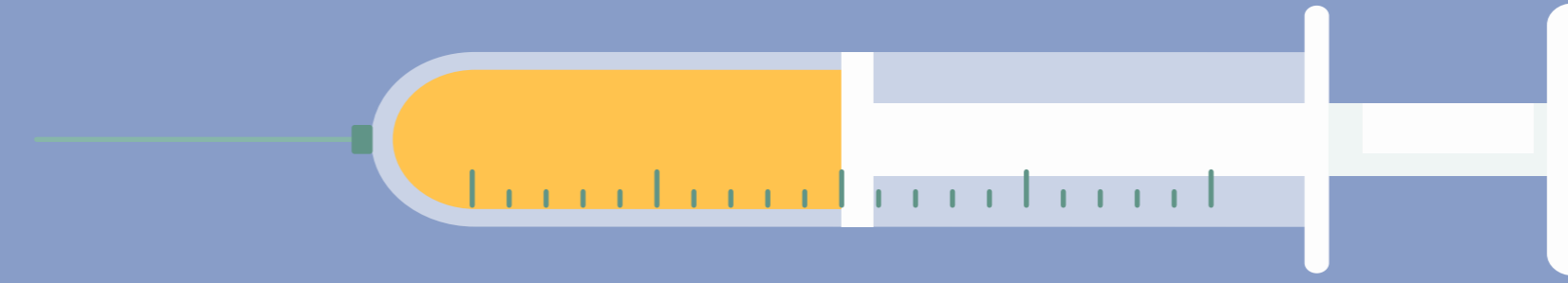


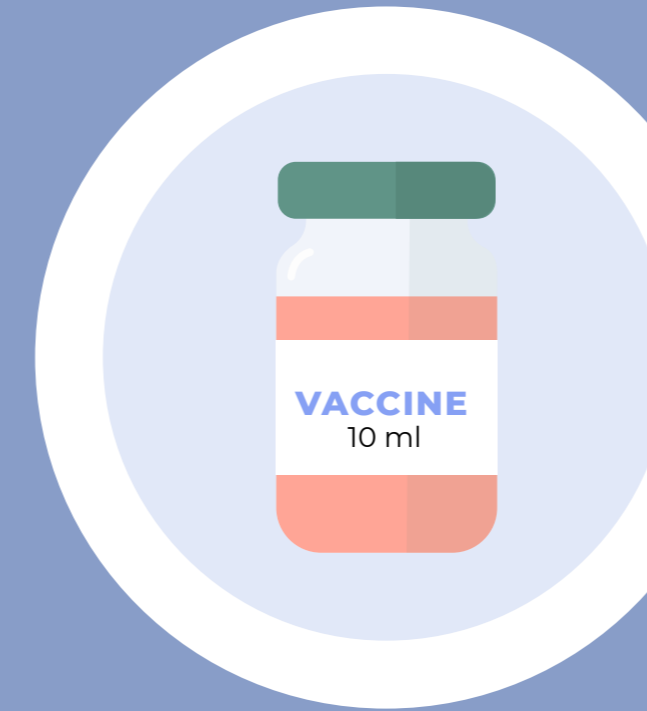
# COVID-19 VACCINE SAFETY

## What you need to know and how you can help



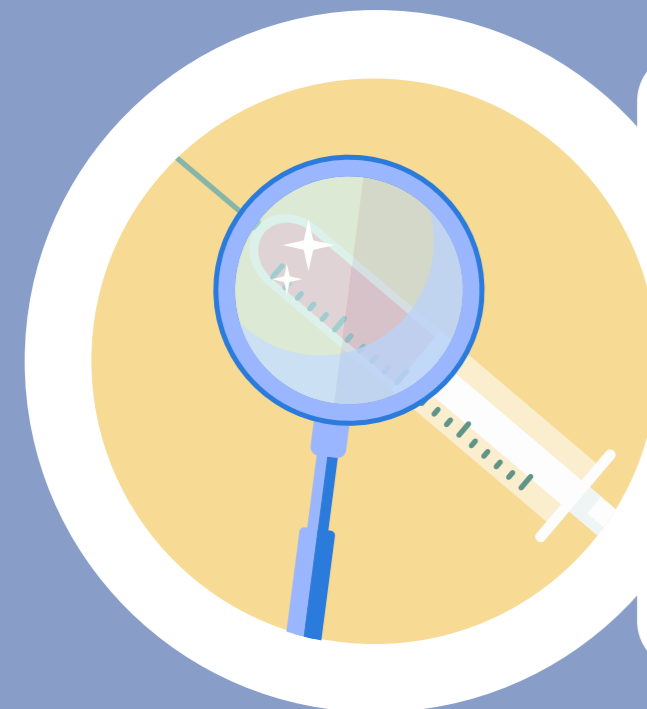
### Most adverse reactions from vaccines are mild to moderate and of limited duration

Common side effects after COVID-19 vaccines are injection site pain, fever, headache and fatigue.



### Record the name of the vaccine, the manufacturer and batch number

If you experience an adverse event, you will be able to provide a more complete report to the relevant authorities.



### Vaccine safety is extensively monitored

The safety of vaccines is extensively monitored by regulators and vaccine manufacturers.



### Act on any unusual or unexpected adverse events

Report any concerns to your healthcare provider or health authority.



### Not all reported adverse events are caused by the vaccine

You can contribute to vaccine safety monitoring by reporting anything that you suspect might be related.



### Continue to follow local COVID-19 recommendations

Even when vaccinated, social distancing, mask wearing and hand washing will continue to be important.
