Chapters

ISoP Chapters are locally established groups of members who address pharmacovigilance needs in their territories. They implement local activities while supporting global and regional ISoP strategies aligned with our mission. Chapters are active in: Africa, Latin America, Europe, Indonesia, China, Middle East and North Africa, North America, South Asia and the Western Pacific (visit our website's chapters section).

Special Interest Groups

A Special Interest Group (SIG) is a collective of ISoP members who volunteer to collaborate on a specific topic that aligns with the scope and aims of ISoP. SIGs are not confined by geographical boundaries. SIGs can collaborate with experts, other groups, associations, or societies outside of ISoP, contingent upon approval from the Executive Committee.

Communities

Groups of ISoP members with similar professional backgrounds (e.g., Industry, Academia, Healthcare, Regulatory) who connect and collaborate across regions. They may engage with external experts or organizations with EC approval.



Meetings, trainings and events

ISoP organizes global events, including the annual global meeting, the mid-year symposium, and regional AI-focused seminars in Europe and North America. Regional meetings are hosted by our chapters, enabling tailored engagement across different areas.
