



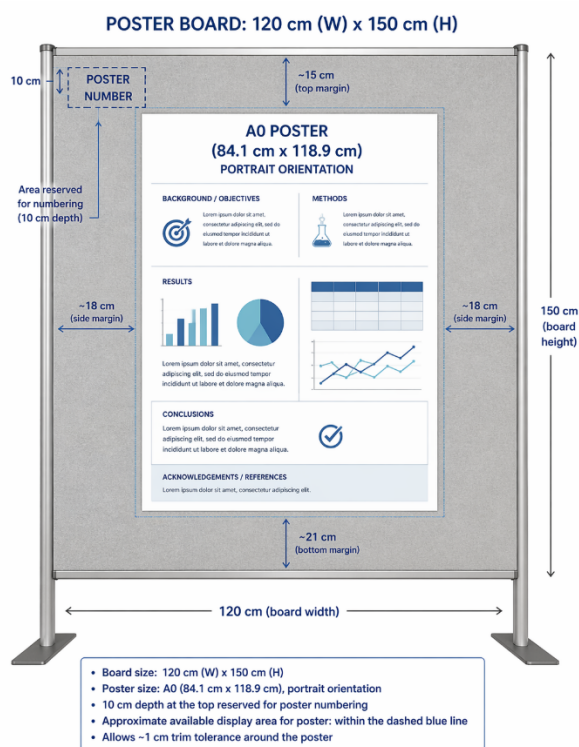
Poster Presentation Guidelines

Poster Format and Size

- Posters must be prepared in **A0 size (84.1 cm × 118.9 cm)**
- **Orientation: Portrait (vertical)**
- Poster boards measure **120 cm (W) × 150 cm (H)**

To ensure consistent display:

- Allow for **~1 cm margin (trim tolerance)** around your poster
- A **10 cm space at the top of the board** is reserved for the poster number
- **Do not exceed A0 dimensions**
- Your poster number is NOT the same as the abstract number
- *See layout diagram below for guidance on positioning and margins*



Poster Content

Your poster should include:

- **Title, authors, affiliations**
- **Background / objectives**

- **Methods**
- **Results** (use figures, tables, and graphs where possible)
- **Conclusions**

Focus on **key messages and findings**.

Do not attempt to reproduce a full manuscript.

Design and Layout

Posters should be:

- **Clear, concise, and visually engaging**
- Structured in a **logical flow** (top to bottom, left to right)
- Readable from a distance (use large fonts and clear headings)

Good practice:

- Use **figures and visuals instead of dense text**
- Keep text brief and focused
- Ensure sufficient **white space**
- Clearly label all figures and tables

Avoid:

- Overcrowded layouts
- Excessive text
- Small or unreadable fonts

Presentation Requirements

- Posters must be **displayed for the full duration** of the assigned session
- The presenting author should be **present at the poster during designated times**
- Be prepared to give a **brief (2–3 minute) overview** of your work
- Engage with attendees and respond to questions

General Guidance

- Content must be **scientifically accurate and balanced**
- Avoid promotional or non-scientific material
- Disclose relevant **conflicts of interest** where applicable
- Supplementary material (e.g. QR codes) may be included if helpful

Purpose of the Poster

In line with International Society of Pharmacovigilance (ISoP) principles, posters should:

- **Visually communicate research clearly and effectively**
- Highlight **key findings and their relevance**
- Encourage **discussion and interaction with attendees**
